




CEERIS – digitalisation steps of docs

CEERIS – Main Purpose



- tackling administrative barriers
- reduce the reporting burdens
- strive for paperless transports

WHO? Reporting Parties, Receiving Authorities, Logistics Users

WHAT? enables vessel operators to fulfil all reporting requirements for a specific


transport in participating countries at once

HOW? By reporting only once with single entering of data



CEERIS – High level architecture







CEERIS – Connection to EuRIS



- Single access point with EuRIS
- EuRIS provides / manages...
 - User Management (incl. user roles + vessel claims)
 - Users + collaboration
 - Reference data management
 - EuRIS: location data (RIS Index & Reference Network Model)
 - ERDMS: cargo data (HS, AND, NST Code, technical name etc.)
 - Route calculations
 - Vessel positions
 - ETA & ATA calculations



CEERIS – Data storage & access



Via ceeris.eu

- 1) Reporting Party enters data fields only once (update at anytime)
- 2) Data is **stored in central DB**, which can be accessed with appropriate rights
 - a) Competent authorities have access to data fields to which they are entitled to access by law
- 3) based on defined **time triggers** authorities have **access** to data fields once vessel passed time trigger to their AOC
- 4) Authorities with corresponding data processing authorisations can **change the dataset** in the central DB at any time (notifications are sent)
- 5) All authorized users have access to updated dataset

Via API

- 1) Ext. Reporting Apps can send electronic reports to CEERIS receiving authorities (e.g. BICS)
- 2) Ext. Receiving Systems can receive electronic reports from CEERIS (e.g. lock systems, statistics, ports, ...)



CEERIS – Main Features / Benefits



REPORTING PARTIES

- Transparent **overview** of all reporting requirements
- Fulfill all reporting requirements; electronic reports are generated and distributed automatically
- Manage electronic reports and communication with authorities
- Provide logistics users access to voyage and transport information in EuRIS
- Cooperation between fleet operators and Consignors/Consignees

RECEIVING AUTHORITIES

- Receive and manage electronic reports
- Cooperate with other authorities and reporting parties

LOGISTICS USERS (if access was granted)

See vessel position, voyage and transport information in EuRIS




CEERIS – Main Experiences



- Many registrations
- Total number of CEERIS users: 477

(*as of 6 March 2023)

- of which 214 are Reporting Parties
- of which 217 are Receiving Authorities
- o of which 46 are **National ERI Administrators**





CEERIS – Main Experiences



- Many registrations
- Positive user feedback
 - Easy reporting due to large pool of reference data
 - Increased transparency in reporting requirements
 - System available in all relevant languages
 - Export PDFs in selected language and format at any time (mimicking paper forms)
- → Consequence: new features for additional needs
 - due to new political developments such as the shift of the Schengen borders
 - due to the large size of certain fleet operators in the Danube corridor





CEERIS – follow up actions



Selected overview of new features

- Various improvements on the GUI content/design/structure
- Indication for vessels that were already controlled (Schengen)
- Improve authority to authority communication
- Improve fleet and agent management (EuRIS)
- Improve vessel claim procedures (EuRIS)
- Consideration of the maritime vessels (without ENI number)
- Connection of remaining ports to CEERIS
- Connection of other (national) receiving systems to CEERIS
- eFTI: investigate the possibility of certifying CEERIS as eFTI platform and authority gate for IWT




